

PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED 2023 BUDGET

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a public hearing on the proposed 2023 budget for the Town of Florence was held at 5 p.m. on November 3, 2022 at the community center. Individuals present were Chairman Tim Bomberg, Supervisors John Holbrook and Shane McLain and Clerk/Treasurer Shelly VanPembrook.

Copies of the 2023 proposed budget were available and Bomberg asked if there were any questions regarding the budget. With no questions on the budget the budget hearing was adjourned on a motion by Holbrook and seconded by McLain. All in favor, motion carried.

November 3, 2022 SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a special town meeting was held on November 3, 2022 immediately following the 5 p.m. public hearing at the community center.

On a motion by VanPembrook and seconded by Holbrook the 2022 levy was approved in the amount of \$869,543 which reflects an allowable increase of 1.198% for net new construction. All in favor, motion carried.

On a motion by McLain and seconded by Bomberg, the town meeting was adjourned. All in favor, motion carried.

November 3, 2022 TOWN BOARD MEETING

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, the Board of Supervisors, Town of Florence met on the 3rd day of November, 2022 immediately following the Special Town Meeting which followed the 5 p.m. budget hearing at the community center. The purpose of this meeting is to adopt the Proposed 2023 Town of Florence Budget.

On a motion by Holbrook and seconded by McLain the 2023 budget was adopted. All in favor, motion carried.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned on a motion by Bomberg and seconded by McLain. All in favor, motion carried.
