

ORDINANCE 9/24/90

**TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF
ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES, MOTORCYCLES AND MOTOR BICYCLES
ON CERTAIN DESIGNATED PROPERTY WITHIN THE
TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE**

The Township of Florence hereby ordains:

SECTION 1. GENERAL PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to ensure the safety of the public and prevent damage to the area now referred to as the Town of Florence Landfill.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The following words, when used in this Ordinance, shall have the following meanings unless otherwise clearly apparent from the context:

A. "All Terrain Vehicle" means an engine-driven device which has a net weight of 500 pounds or less, which has a width of 46 inches or less, which is equipped with a seat designed to be straddled by the operator and which is designed to travel on three (3) or more low-pressure tires.

B. "Motor Bicycle" means a bicycle to which a power unit not an integral part of the vehicle has been added to permit the vehicle to travel at a speed of not more than 30 miles per hour with a 150 pound rider on a dry, level, hard usrface with no wind and having a seat for the operator.

C. "Motorcycle" means a motor vehicle, including a tractor, which is capable of speeds in excess of 30 miles per hour with a 150 pound rider on a dry level, hard surface with no wind, with a power source as an integral part of the vehicle.

D. "Town of Florence Landfill" shall mean that area of the Township of Florence which includes Sec. 4-39-19 of State Highway Plot East Lots 1 through 17 and Lots 24 through 29.

SECTION 3. PROHIBITIONS.

A. No person shall ride or in any manner use an All Terrain Vehicle, Motor Bicycle or Motorcycle within the Town of Florence Landfill.

SECTION 4. PENALTIES.

Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100) or ninety (90) days in jail or both.

SECTION 5. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.


All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of any such conflict hereby repealed.


EFFECTIVE DATE
