

Town of Florence
Ordinance #05-24-2010(2)
Minimum Highway Design Standards

The Town Board of the Town of Florence, County of Florence, State of Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION I

STATUTORY AUTHORITY. Pursuant to Section 82.50(1)(c) of Wisconsin Statutes the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Florence, Florence Co. WI do ordain as follows the minimum for town road standards:

SECTION II

ROAD DESIGN STANDARDS. The following minimum design standards shall apply to all new construction under this ordinance:

Right-of Way	-	66 Feet (4 rods)
Roadway Width	-	30 Feet
Traveled Way	-	22 Feet
Shoulder	-	4 Feet
Ditch	-	1.5 Feet
Slope	-	4.1 Inch (6' minimum)
Crushed Gravel	-	6 Inches (Compacted in place)
Graded	-	3" Crown @ (slope (min) 0.015")
Type of Paving	-	Approved by Town Board

- All cul-de-sacs shall have a 50' radius and a 130' (minimum) right-of-way.
- Culverts for newly constructed driveways must be furnished by property owners. Type and size shall be determined by town officials.
- The Town of Florence will require an as-built drawing.
- Before laying out of any road is started, town officials must approve initial plan and their approval will be required before proceeding with every stage of construction.

SECTION III

EFFECTIVE DATES. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

SECTION IV
