

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR NO PILING OR STORING OF WOOD PRODUCTS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF ANY TOWN ROAD RIGHT OF WAY.

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Florence do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. No person, firm or corporation shall pile or store any wood products within the boundaries of any town road right of way.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit to the Town of Florence the sum of not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, as adjudged by the Court, plus the costs of prosecution as taxed and assessed by the Court, and in default of payment of said forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the county jail of Florence County for such period of time, but not exceeding thirty (30) days, as shall be adjudged by the Court unless said forfeiture and costs be sooner paid.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and legal publication.

### Ordinance No. 6/24/91
